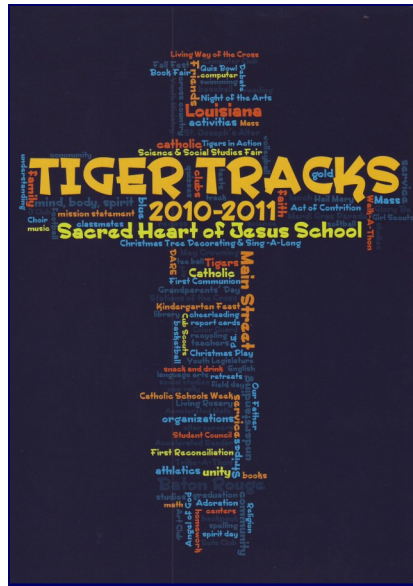
All Saints' Day
